

The lithium-ion batteries used in power banks may emit smoke or catch fire due to impact or damage. To strengthen measures against smoke and fire from power banks on board and to improve cabin safety, please take the following precautions.

1. Do NOT put power banks in checked baggage!

Power banks are prohibited in checked baggage. Please carry them with you on board.



2. Up to a watt-hour rating of 160Wh!

Power banks with a watt-hour rating exceeding 160Wh are prohibited.

Example) $Wh = Capacity (Ah) \times Voltage (V)$
 $Wh = Capacity (mAh) \times Voltage (V) \div 1,000$

Voltage: 3.7V (99.9Wh)

3. Protect each power bank individually to prevent short circuits!

To prevent short circuits, apply insulating tape to the terminals, place the battery in a case or storage bag, and avoid putting multiple batteries or metal items in the same bag.



4. Do NOT place power banks in overhead compartments!

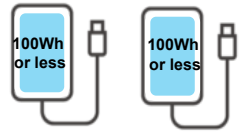
Please keep it in a seat pocket or similar location that is close to you.

5. Up to 2 power banks per passenger!

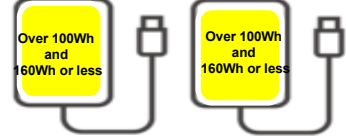
① If you have 2 power banks with a capacity of 100Wh or less

Up to 2

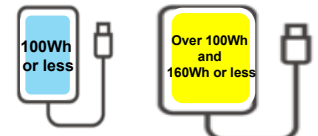
② If you have 2 power banks (over 100Wh and 160Wh or less)



Spare batteries (100Wh or less)
No quantity limit

Spare batteries (over 100Wh and 160Wh or less)
Prohibited

③ If you have 1 power bank each for 100Wh or less and for over 100Wh and 160Wh or less



Spare batteries (100Wh or less)
No quantity limit

Spare batteries (over 100Wh and 160Wh or less)
Up to 1

6. Charging power banks on board is prohibited!

Charging power banks using the aircraft's power supply is prohibited.



7. Do NOT use power banks to charge other electronic devices during the flight!

Please do not charge other electronic devices using the power bank.
Please charge your electronic devices using the onboard power outlets.



[Power Bank]

• Devices with built-in lithium-ion batteries used to charge other electronic devices



[Spare Lithium-ion Battery]

- Spare batteries for electronic devices such as digital cameras
- Spare batteries removed from electronic devices



*Violations of items 1-3, 5 and 6 may be subject to penalties under aviation law.
 * Power banks may also not be transportable by air as cargo via courier services. Please be sure to declare them to the courier service provider and follow their instructions.
 *Some airlines may apply stricter rules. Please follow the airline instructions.
