The 21st Japan-Korea Road Meeting

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) and the Ministry of Land Infrastructure and Transport (MOLIT) held “the 21st Japan-Korea Road Meeting” on July 23rd.

In this meeting, we exchanged knowledge concerning “Autonomous Driving Infrastructure”, “Decarbonization Policies”, “Road Paving Technology”, “Traffic Safety”, etc. We also confirmed the continuous exchange of technology between Japan and Korea.

Based on the “Implementation Arrangement on the Japan–Korea Road Meeting” signed in 1995, this meeting is held to promote cooperation in the road sector of both countries, improve road policy and promote road development.
