**The 39th Japan-China Road Meeting (Report)**

--- Technical exchange in the road sector between Japan and China ---

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) of Japan, the Ministry of Transport of the People's Republic of China (PRC), and the Chongqing Municipal Transportation Commission held the 39th Japan-China Road Meeting on October 15th in Beijing and on the 16th in Chongqing.

At this meeting, we exchanged knowledge concerning “Disaster Monitoring and Alerts”, “Road Digital Transformation(DX)”, “Smart Roads”, “Decarbonization”. We also confirmed the continuous exchange of technology between Japan and China.

Based on the the agreement for “Japan-China Road Meeting” signed in 1984, this meeting has been held for nearly 40 years to advance technical exchanges in the road sector.
